



You will meet with a judge who will discuss your outfit with you (why you chose this outfit, what you like about it, how to care for it, where you would wear it, etc.) You will be judged on how the outfit (and accessories) look and your ability to discuss your outfit with the judge.

- 5. No frosting or toppings on any entries except self-determined.




